 - Expenditure totalling \$118,356,000 as summarised in the 2012/13 Operational Plan and Program Budget and that the funds to cover such expenditure be voted,
 - The 2012/13 List of unfunded Works and Services,
 - The 2012/13 Fees and Charges, including the amendment proposed within this report,
 - The continuation of the Stormwater Management Levy as outlined in this report and program of works in the 2012/13 Operating Plan,
 - Approve the level of loan borrowings identified within the 2012/13 budget of \$1,600,000,
 - Approve the transfer of \$515,000 to the Central Administration Building Reserve as allowed for in the 2012/13 budget,
 - Approve the transfer of \$1,374,000, from the Working Funds Reserve to fund the 2012/13 Councillor nominated Capital Works Program,
 - Approve the transfer of \$90,000 from the Camden Town Centre Reserve to fund the Camden Town Centre traffic studies and minor concept works,
 - Approve the transfer of \$50,000 from the Stormwater Management Levy Reserve to fund the retro-fitting of the Lake Annan Gross Pollutant Trap,
 - Approve the transfer of \$291,000 from the Working Funds Reserve to assist in funding Council's major recurrent capital works programs including the road reconstruction program,
 - Approve the allocation of the 2012/13 budget surplus as follows:

CC01 Land Acquisition Under Land Acquisition (Just Terms Compensation) Act 1991 - Gregory Hills (1)

Resolution: Moved Councillor Funnell, Seconded Councillor Symkowiak that Council:

- i. acquire the subject property, Lot 19 DP 28024, 73 Turner Road, Gregory Hills under the hardship provision of Section 24 of the Land Acquisition (Just Terms Compensation) Act 1991;
- ii. delegate authority to the General Manager to acquire Lot 19 DP 28024, 73 Turner Road, Gregory Hills by the most expedient method available under Section 25 of the Act, either by the compulsory process or by negotiated agreement;
- iii. endorse that, in the event that negotiated agreement cannot be reached, the necessary application for compulsory acquisition be made to the Minister for Local Government and / or the Governor; and
- iv. affix the Council Seal to all of the relevant documentation associated with the acquisition of Lot 19 DP 28024, 73 Turner Road, Gregory Hills.

- ii. transfer sufficient funds from Section 94 to acquire the land as identified in this report;
- iii. authorise the Mayor and General Manager to sign under seal all documentation associated with the acquisition of Lot 1 DP 707250.
- iv. endorse that, in the event negotiated agreement cannot be reached for the acquisition of Part Lot 99 DP 1121639 and/or Part Lot 2 DP 516583, Springs Road, Spring Farm the necessary application for compulsory acquisition be made to the

Minister for Local Government and / or the Governor pursuant to the Land Acquisition (Just Terms Compensation) Act 1991 and the Roads Act, 1993.

v. affix the Council Seal to all of the relevant documentation associated with the compulsory acquisition of Lot 99 DP 1121639 and/or Lot 2 DP 516583 Springs Road, Spring Farm.
