Councillor Campbell noted that she had a non-pecuniary interest and no conflict of interest in regards to ORD07. Councillor Campbell noted that she was a member of the NSW State Executive of the Country Women's Association, who had a stance against coal seam gas.

Ms Frances Vumbaca addressed Council on the issues related to flood mapping in the North Ward. Ms Vumbaca asked if the land in the North Ward is to be acquired by compulsory acquisition, will it be under the Just Terms Act? Also, will the land owner have any benefit from the profits made? Both questions were taken on notice.

Mr Tony Van Dyk addressed Council on the issues relating to flood mapping.

Mr George Smiroldo addressed Council on the continued use of Catherine Field Community Hall.

Mr Michael Brooker addressed Council on the subdivision of land to create 94

residential lots and the construction of new roads at 172, 172A, 186 Richardson Road and 12B Moreton Bay Avenue, Spring Farm.

Ms Joan Scott addressed Council on the future of Camden generally. Ms Scott asked some questions regarding wells in Gundungurra Reserve including how much does Council receive for this? Is this figure an ongoing yearly figure and does Council intend to put in more wells? These questions were taken on notice.

Ms Carmel and Mr Steven Gobbo addressed Council on flood mapping in Rossmore. Mr & Mrs Gobbo asked the following questions which were taken on notice: At what height level determines a flood? How long does it take for this water to recede? What is the difference between a flash flood and an actual flood? Can a watercourse be dammed? Is it legal to dam a watercourse? Have the 1:100 flood levels changed? If so, what mitigation works will be carried out and in what timeframe? Are residents compensated for any loss? Residents would like clarification on the flood mapping and answers as to why it has changed.
