ORD01 Section 96(2) Modification Application - Modifications to Approved Cemetery

Resolution: <u>Moved</u> Councillor Campbell, Seconded Councillor Dewbery that Council approve Section 96(2) Modification No 1203(2)/2010 for the modification of approved cemetery works to Narellan Cemetery at 6 Richardson Road, Narellan subject to the conditions listed above and with the following amendments:

- (i) the access path to the heritage section be extended to the length of the path as shown on the plan (Attachment 2) of the Supporting Documents;
- (ii) that a condition of consent be included to allow the general public access to the cemetery during daylight hours;
- (iii) that condition (24) be amended to read "The signs may include information such as dates of burials and the names of any local or significant deceased persons. All details of the signs, including the content, size, font, colours, materials and locations are to be determined in consultation with the representatives of the Friends of Narellan Cemetery, the owners of the cemetery **and Council** prior to the completion of Stage 1 works." (change highlighted in bold).
