- iii. subject to there being no unresolved submissions as a result of the public notification of the Voluntary Planning Agreement and the Section 96 modification to DA 167/2014 being determined:
 - execute the Narellan Town Centre Planning Agreement pursuant to Council's Power of Attorney granted on 27 August 2013, Minute Number ORD215/13, or by affixing the Common Seal of Council and subject to the provision of documents required by Clause 33 of the Agreement;
 - b. notify the Minister of Planning and provide a copy of the Narellan Town Centre VPA in accordance with the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* and *Regulations*; and
 - c. request that the applicant submits a Section 96 modification for the Dan

Murphy's development, after the Planning Agreement has been executed, to replace conditions of consent relating to Section 94 Contributions with a requirement to satisfy the obligations of the Planning Agreement.
