  - b. it is anticipated that a satisfactory result can be achieved through negotiating with one or more of the Nominated Persons in the manner described in the Report:
- iv. that, in accordance with s.178 (4)(b) of the Regulation, notes that the reason for Council determining to enter into negotiations with the Nominated Persons, is that:
  - Council is satisfied that each of the Nominated Persons would be capable of undertaking the relevant services for which they have been nominated in the Report; and
  - b. it is anticipated that a satisfactory outcome can be achieved through negotiations with one or more of the Nominated Persons;
- v. that all tenderers are notified as appropriate that no tenders for RFT T21/13 were accepted; and
