LOCAL ROADS PACKAGE TO BENEFIT CAMDEN TOWN CENTRE

Funding for additional road projects in Camden has been given the green light under the first round of the Australian Government funded Local Roads Package for Western Sydney, part of the \$3.6 billion Western Sydney Infrastructure Plan.

Assistant Minister for Infrastructure and Regional Development, Jamie Briggs and NSW Minister for Roads and Freight, Duncan Gay visited Camden yesterday to make the exciting announcement of funding for three projects within the Camden Local Government Area.

Mayor of Camden, Cr Lara Symkowiak, who was joined yesterday by Mr Russell Matheson MP, Member for Macarthur and Mr Chris Patterson MP, Member for Camden, is delighted these projects have been approved under the Federal Government's \$200 million Local Roads Package.

"This funding will support the Camden Town Centre enhancement works and is a fantastic result for Camden."

"My Council recently approved a number of key initiatives for infrastructure improvements to the Camden Town Centre and this funding will support these improvements through improved traffic flow, enhanced safety, and improved connectivity with the regional road network."
