"The new play equipment includes an exciting six-way swing, a cable ride, rodeo board and an air glide which are all welcome additions for young people in our area."

"We have retained the fitness equipment, added a new picnic shelter and included a basket swing for younger children to ensure this much-loved space provides a quality experience for the entire family."

"Council is committed to providing valuable recreational opportunities to our residents. Over the next few years, residents can expect to see a range of exciting new and upgraded recreational facilities including a new outdoor youth space for young people in Birriwa Reserve, Mount Annan and the Narellan Sports Hub."

The total cost of the project was \$101,000. John Peat Reserve is located off Chellaston Street in Camden.
