Funding available for youth projects

Council is offering funding for local youth focused activities as part of its Youth OutReach Program for 2017-2018.

Local youth services and community groups can now submit an Expression of Interest for partnership funding for an innovative youth project.

"Council is committed to supporting young people through the provision of events, activities and facilities designed especially for them," said Mayor Lara Symkowiak.

"We want to be sure that young people are involved in the community and establish connections that help them to build resilience and a sense of belonging," Cr Symkowiak said.

The partnership funding program provides up to \$4,000 funding for activities to be held between 1 July 2017 and 30 June 2018 within the Camden Local Government Area for people aged 12-25 years.

Funding must be equally matched by the applicants and address key directions of the Camden 2040 Community Strategic Plan.
