Free microchipping for cats and dogs in Camden LGA

Council is offering its residents free microchipping for cats and dogs until the end of November.

The three month program is available as part of Council's Permanent Identification Program (PIP) to improve the safety of dogs and cats living in the Camden area.

"Microchipping is an important measure to ensuring that pets can be returned home promptly if they are lost or stolen," said Mayor Lara Symkowiak.
