New location for Council's Chemical Cleanout

Residents can dispose of their old and unwanted hazardous chemical waste at a new location during Camden Council's Chemical Cleanout event early next year.

Chemical CleanOut is a joint event between Camden Council and the NSW Environmental Protection Authority and will be held on Sunday 28 January.

Previously held at Onslow Park in Camden, hazardous chemicals can now be disposed of at Camden Council's Works Depot located at 5 Millwood Avenue, Narellan – just off Graham Hill Road.

"Our Chemical Cleanout allows residents to do something good for the environment while also freeing up some room in their homes," said Mayor Lara Symkowiak.

"This event has moved to a new location to help manage the growing number of attendees," she said.

"All chemicals collected on the day are disposed of in a safe and environmentally friendly manner so don't forget to pencil in the event."

Items that will be accepted on the day include:-

- Solvents and household cleaners
- Floor care products
- Ammonia-based cleaners
- · Pesticides and herbicides
- Poisons
- Pool chemicals
- Hobby chemicals
- Motor fuels
- Fluorescent globes and tubes
- Acids and alkalis
- Smoke detectors
- Paint and paint-related products
- Gas bottles
- Fire extinguishers
- Car and household batteries
