Lighting of community Christmas tree

The countdown is on until the lighting of the Camden community Christmas tree in Camden Town Centre. This years' lighting ceremony will take place as part of the Camden Jacaranda Festival celebrations on Saturday 24 November.

Mayor, Cr Peter Sidgreaves said he was looking forward to seeing the Christmas tree, decorations, and the jacaranda tree lights all being turned on.
