Applications open 1st June for not for profit groups and organisations to apply for up to \$6500 in funding for projects in the Camden area for the local community.

The small grants program is a component of Council's Community Financial Assistance Program which fosters the development of a cohesive, healthy and strong community.

"This funding program is one of the ways that we can support community based initiatives that support our residents," said Mayor Lara Symkowiak.

"It's an opportunity to develop grass roots events and projects that will have a real benefit for our community," Cr Symkowiak said.
