Oran Park Library wins community project award

The Oran Park Library has been recognised as a leading public facility and awarded the Western Sydney Leadership Dialogue Outstanding Community Project for 2018.

Last week the project partners of Council, Landcom and Greenfields Development Corporation were presented with the prestigious award at the Boomtown! Dinner in Sydney.

The 2500m2 library was opened in June this year and includes a community resource centre, interactive digital facilities, function centre and designated children's area.

"This library is a tribute to the collaborative effort of everyone involved in its design and delivery to create a remarkable community space for people to engage," said Mayor Peter Sidgreaves.

"It is a contemporary facility that incorporates modern technologies to offer interactive digital components while maintaining ties to history through artwork and images," Cr Sidgreaves said.

"The clever design also allows for sustainable features to reduce its eco footprint including air conditioning linked to the solar power generated on the Council administration building and efficient water use," he said.

"The award is recognition of the vision for the library and the wider master planning of Oran Park Town overall."

The Western Sydney Leadership Dialogue Awards recognise outstanding projects in Western Sydney that are contributing towards creating the world leading Western Parkland City centred around the Western Sydney Airport.
