Grandparents and carers are invited to attend a special event to kick back and relax at Oran Park Library later this month.

To celebrate Grandparents Day this year, Council will host a free Storytime session and playgroup for children and their grandparents or carers on Thursday 25 October.

The event will be followed by a Café Connect session that will give grandparents an opportunity to relax and enjoy a coffee and healthy food options while meeting other older residents and local service providers.

Mayor of Camden, Cr Peter Sidgreaves said the event would acknowledge the important role of grandparents and older carers in raising children.

"Grandparents shape the lives of our children by passing on culture, traditions and knowledge and this is a day to remember and celebrate that," Cr Sidgreaves said.
