Children under five years will have their own dedicated space at Bounce Town, with a separate space filled with toys and equipment that will help develop motor skills.

Toddler Town will have shaded seating for parents, as well as:

- Foot-powered princess, fire engine and police cars.

Mayor of Camden, Cr Peter Sidgreaves said the event, to be held on **Wednesday 17 April, 10am-3pm, at Town Park, Central Avenue, Oran Park**, had something for everyone.

"The event will have 21 inflatable activities, 10 of which have never been seen in Australia before!" Cr Sidgreaves said.

"Not to mention the food stalls to enjoy under the shaded seating.

"Parents can also take their toddlers next door, to Oran Park Library, for 30 minutes of stories, songs, rhymes, craft and movement. We have Babies into Books, for babies from birth to two years, at 10am and then Storytime, for children aged between two and five years, at 11am."
