Residents are invited to the official opening of the 44th annual Camden Art Prize, on Friday 3 May, 7.30pm, at Camden Civic Centre.

The exhibition boasts more than 340 different artworks, with winners announced on the night. It is free to view and will be open on:

- Saturday 4 May, 10am-6pm;
- Sunday 5 May, 10am-5pm;
- Monday 6 May, 12.30-5pm;
- Tuesday 7 May, 12.30-5pm;
- Wednesday 8 May, 12.30-5pm;
- Thursday 9 May, 12.30-6pm; and
- Friday 10 May, 12.30-4pm.

Mayor of Camden, Cr Theresa Fedeli, said the annual event puts the spotlight on artists and helps promote visual arts across Camden and the country.

"This event is a prestigious opportunity for artists at all levels to express themselves and help broaden and stimulate community perception of art and artists," Cr Fedeli said.

"Camden Art Prize Committee will purchase the winning artwork and donate it to Council for display as part of the Camden Council Public Art Collection, for the community to enjoy for many years to come."

Residents also have the opportunity to see the exhibition in style, with Art After Dark. On Thursday 9 May, 6.30pm, a local artist guide will walk residents through the exhibition with professional commentary. Tickets are just \$15 and includes a glass of wine and snacks.
