Finish the school holidays with Humpty

There's an exciting finish planned for the school holidays with everyone's favourite children's television program, Play School, heading to Camden.

The 40-minute show, *Humpty's Showtime*, will be performed live on Friday 11 October at Camden Civic Centre. The 10am and noon shows are sold out, but there are still tickets available to the 2pm show.

It will feature Teo and Emma, just like on TV, who promise to have Play School fans singing, dancing and jumping for joy. Humpty will gather the Play School toys to help with the big spectacular, with starring roles for Jemima, Big Ted, Little Ted and guest appearances from other Play School favourites along the way.

Mayor of Camden, Cr Theresa Fedeli, said the show was specially designed to delight pre-schoolers and parents alike.

"Everything in the concert is carefully paced especially for children," Cr Fedeli said.

"There are songs to move to and lots of audience participation which will totally captivate the little ones. There will also be quiet times to watch, listen and learn, which I know the parents will enjoy."

Tickets for *Humpty's Showtime* are \$22, plus a booking fee.

This performance will mark the end of the school holidays, but residents can rest assured there will still be lots for kids of all ages to do throughout the Camden area. These include:

- Mini builders, for children aged 2-3 years, at Camden Library. This program uses Lego to develop early literacy and science, technology, engineering and mathematics skills;
- Storytime, for children aged 2-5 years, at Camden, Narellan and Oran Park Libraries. These weekly, 30-minute sessions are filled with stories, songs and craft;
- Open Space sessions at Narellan Library. These free, self-directed sessions are for residents of any age to use, experiment with and enjoy the capabilities of The Space Digital Studios; and
- Junior and Teen Gym classes, for young people aged 11-14 years, at Mount Annan Leisure Centre. These classes will help participants build strength, fitness and flexibility, as well as confidence and social skills.
