Bright ideas for energy efficiency

Local business owners and staff are invited to learn some bright ideas for energy efficiency at a FREE course hosted by Camden Council.

Energy 101 for Small Business, facilitated by the NSW Government, will be held on **Tuesday 29 October**, **5.30-7pm**, **at Camden Sports Club**. The course will teach attendees how to:

- Analyse their energy bills;
- Understand how their business uses energy;
- · Identify energy saving opportunities, including no and low-cost solutions; and
- Learn about funding options and resources.

Every business who attends will also be given the opportunity to claim a two-hour, one-on-one e-coaching session, worth \$400, for FREE.

Mayor of Camden, Cr Theresa Fedeli, encouraged local small businesses to take advantage of the many learning opportunities available throughout October.

"We've scheduled more events for this year's Small Business Month than any other year," Cr Fedeli said.

"There are approximately 3,000 local businesses which are classified as 'small', which means they employ 15 people or less.

"These businesses are so hard-working, so it's really important we celebrate them and provide affordable opportunities for them to grow. Having these businesses improve themselves is fantastic for the Camden area, because it means our local economy will be stronger."
