## **Funding for Narellan Sports Hub**

Camden residents have received another win with an additional \$5 million NSW Government funding for further improvements to the Narellan Sports Hub.

The funding, coupled with this week's \$15 million joint funding announcement as part of the Western Parkland City Liveability program, will bring the total to \$20 million to be invested in sport and recreation facilities for our residents.

Mayor of Camden, Cr Peter Sidgreaves welcomed the funding and said it was another great win for the community.

"These state-of-the-art facilities will breathe new life into the greater Camden area allowing more people to participate in sport," Cr Sidgreaves said.

"Council is committed to providing our residents with the highest quality sport and recreation facilities, and this funding will ensure we continue to deliver exceptional facilities to cater for the growing needs of our community.

"I thank the NSW Government for their contribution and look forward to seeing Narellan Sports Hub continue to grow."

The NSW Government's \$5 million funding will go towards stage 2 of the Narellan Sports Hub project.
