RTA Representative

Camden Chamber of Commerce Representative

1. Emergency Vehicle Access to Werombi Road Residential Development
Thanks to the Traffic Engineer for the prompt response to initial enquiry, the entrance sign has since been removed. The Camden West Brigade (RFS) has queried the load capacity and design accessibility for Category 1 tankers for the concrete road off Werombi Road. Could this be followed up?

Traffic Engineer: This will be followed up with the relevant branch.

2. Are the LTC members able to receive a copy of the Road Safety Audit Report for Old Hume Highway?

Transport Planner: In discussions with the RTA Council was advised that the report is a technical review that forms part of a larger assessment process and should not be circulated in isolation. Both Council and the RTA are considering the report and the appropriate treatments to implement. This assessment will be referred to the LTC and Council.
