TC01 BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE COMMITTEE'S LAST REPORT DATED 9 MAY 2005

Resolution: Upon review of the issue of on-street parking in Queen Street, Narellan the Traffic Committee recommended that

- i. the minutes of the Local Traffic Committee meeting dated 9 May 2005 be adopted.
- ii. Council not permit kerbside parking at location 'A' for the following reasons:
 - A. the location provides just one space in isolation and close proximity to an intersection.
 - B. a parked vehicle creates a potential conflict for turning vehicles, especially trucks delivering goods to the Narellan Town Centre.

TC03 SIR WARWICK FAIRFAX DRIVE, HARRINGTON PARK - BUS ZONE ALTERATION

Resolution: That Council:

- i. Install the following parking restrictions along the length of the indented bus bay in Sir Warwick Fairfax Drive, outside Harrington Park Primary School:
 - Parking - 2 minutes (School Days) 8.00 to 9.30 am and 2.30 to 4.00 pm
 - Bus Zone (School Days) 9.30 to 2.30 pm
- ii. Implement these parking restrictions on the provision that the Harrington Park Primary School and Parents and Citizens Association accept the restrictions are temporary and subject to review if required for school bus parking.
- iii. Request the school to use their best endeavours to liaise with the school community to ensure that the revised parking in the bus bay is not misused by parents.
- iv. Notify the property owners opposite the bus bay of Council's decision.
