

4. Our place

Camden Council provides a range of services and facilities to the community. These include libraries at Camden and Narellan, Civic Centre for celebratory functions and conferences, Family Day Care, Parks and Community Centres to name a few. There is a need to provide a variety of accessible services and places to meet the continuously changing needs and diverse age groups of the community.

The halls, community centres and function rooms that are available include the AH & I Hall, Birriwa Reserve Clubrooms, Camden Civic Centre, Catherine Field Community Hall, Currans Hill Community Centre, Harrington Park Community Centre, Jack Nash Reserve, Leppington Progress Association Hall, Mount Annan Community Cottage and Narellan Community Centre.

Appendix 7.3 identifies maps of Camden LGA suburbs portraying services, facilities, parks and reserves including those that were audited.

Due to the large amount of growth the Camden Local Government Area has been experiencing and will experience more in the near future, there is a need to provide a vast range of services and facilities. Council is responsible for providing infrastructure to service and meet the needs of the population.

In providing these facilities it is also important that Council concentrates on improving access to existing facilities and ensures that new facilities incorporate access for people with a disability.
