

# **CAMDEN COUNCIL WHEELIE BIN BEAT BOX SOUND SYSTEM**

## **TERMS OF CONDITION FOR HIRE**



Conceived and endorsed by the Community NSW Western Sydney Cluster Group Funderground: the Wheelie Bin Beat Box 2011 project aims to provide a platform for Western Sydney young people to perform live music, original musical composition or present live DJ mixes in live sites across a number of local government areas in Western Sydney.

The Wheelie Bin Beat Box is a self-contained, solar powered amplification unit with iPod/Laptop connectivity designed to be set-up and used at any outdoor or indoor event. This system comes with a silver iPod shuffle, microphone, back up battery pack and of course – the Wheelie Bin!

The Wheelie Bin Beat Box Sound System is an individually designed, hand crafted unit. Featuring high volume, high fidelity sound, the Wheelie Bin Beat Box Sound System is most suited to small to medium sized gatherings like picnics, street parties or mobile public events. Operation is plug\_and\_play via USB ports that will support, laptop, ipod, mixing deck and CD players.

The Wheelie Bin beat Box Sound System is available for hire for not-for-profit community groups, charitable organisations, youth services and schools.

### **How can people use the Wheelie Bin Sound System?**

The wheelie bin sound system can be used in one of two ways.

1. As an amplification system for live performance. Using the microphone function on the system young people can sing and/or amplify their own musical instrument with the sound system.
2. Using the inputs supplied the sound system becomes a simple plug and play device. The system can be used to present mixed or sampled edited original music from an iPod, iPad or laptop.

For instructions on how to use the unit please see the information sheet that is secured to the inside of the Wheelie Bin Beat Box lid.

<h3><b><u>WHEELIE BIN HIRE TERMS &amp; CONDITIONS</u></b></h3> <p><b>Cost:</b> The Wheelie Bin Beat Box Sound System is free to hire to not-for-profit community groups/organisations that will provide benefit for young people in the Camden LGA.</p> <p><b>Bond:</b> The individual/organisation is responsible for the full replacement cost of any damages or breakages to the Wheelie Bin, its fittings and contents. Credit card details are required from the individual/organisation at time of booking. These details will be used to charge an amount of no more than \$500 if the equipment is returned damaged. <i>Note: No amount will be charged to the credit card unless the equipment is damaged or stolen.</i> You will be invoiced for the FULL AMOUNT (\$1300) if the Wheelie Bin and it's contents are stolen.</p> <p><b>Pick up &amp; Drop off:</b> Access to pick up and drop off the Wheelie Bin is through Camden Council Customer Service Narellan Office, 19 Queen St, Narellan NSW 2567. Times of pick up and drop offs are to be completed Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:30am and 5pm.</p> <p><b>Availability &amp; Bookings:</b> Original signed forms are only accepted (no copies). Confirmation of booking is upon receipt of signed terms. Tentative bookings will be held for a maximum of 14 days. Camden Council reserves the right to refuse any booking.</p> <p><b>Agreed Use:</b> All equipment hired must be returned, packed up neatly and in its original condition as hired out. Should any parts be missing or damaged on return, a fee will be charged to your service/organisation. No food or drink should touch any parts of the bin (including the solar panel lid section). Any equipment not provided by Council to use with the Wheelie Bin, is used at your own risk. Council will not be liable for any damages caused to iPods/laptops that are not owned by Council. <i>Note: Please ensure all equipment is used in a safe and suitable manner including monitoring it's usage by other people. Please understand that the Wheelie Bin Beat Box Sound System and it's equipment are valued at \$1300.</i></p> <p><b>Alterations:</b> Under no circumstances should any person touch or alter any of the electrical leads or speaker wires inside the Wheelie Bin. If for some unknown reason the system is not working (after reading all instructions provided) please shut down the system and phone (02) 4645 5021.</p> <p><b>Late returns:</b> If you return the equipment after the specified hire dates, your organisation will be impacted upon in regards to future use and hire of equipment. <i>Your organisation may also be liable for paying a late fee of \$50 per day.</i></p>
