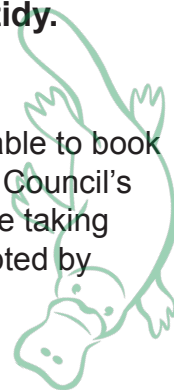


# IMPORTANT!

You must follow these conditions as material placed on the kerbside in a manner contrary to this brochure will not be collected. Such material could be considered illegal dumping and offenders may be prosecuted. Let's work together to keep our streets tidy.

## Still too much material? Additional Services Available.

If you find that after your 2 collections you still have material you would like removed, you are able to book in for additional cleanup services. A fee applies to these additional services and can be paid at Council's Customer Service Centres before booking. Contact 4654 7777 for details. Other options include taking your waste to Jacks Gully Waste Management Facility. Items that can be reused may be accepted by local charity organisations.



## Terms and Conditions

- The details on this brochure (or updated versions thereof) form part of the terms and conditions of the Kerbside Cleanup.
- The kerbside is public land. Any materials placed on the kerbside in a manner contrary to these terms and conditions may be considered littering or waste pollution of land which are prosecutable offences under the POEO Act, 1997.
- Only two (2) fee-free Cleanups are available for any residential property per financial year.
- Bookings are based on availability. Council makes no guarantee as to the time elapse from call to booking date.
- Kerbside Cleanup services to multi-unit dwellings may be available only by special arrangement.
- Council reserves the right to allocate the date of the collection day at the point of booking and to change it where necessary.
- Waste from commercial or industrial premises does not form part of the Kerbside Cleanup and will not be collected.
- All material placed on the kerbside is considered the property owner or tenant's responsibility until collected by Council.

## Kerbside Collection Service

### Step 1

Do not put your unwanted material on the kerbside until you have made a booking with Council.

### Step 2

Once you know what day your collection will be you can put your material out no earlier than 48 hours (2 days) before the collection date. This will help keep our streets safe and tidy.

### Step 3

Get the volume right. Only 3 cubic metres of material will be accepted from each property (3m x 1m x 1m - approximately one small box trailer load).

### Step 4

Separate the general waste, metals and greenwaste into 3 piles.



## Sort Materials Into Three Different Piles

A total of three cubic metres (about one small box trailer load) of material will be accepted.

### GENERAL ITEMS



- Bulky household items such as furniture - large items should be dismantled and doors removed.
- Mattresses.
- Children's toys.
- Barbeques (not the gas bottle).
- Carpet cut and rolled into 1 metre lengths, limited to 1 room only.



- No food waste or recyclables.
- No construction, demolition or renovation materials.
- No hazardous waste (e.g. fuels, oils, acids, thinners, paints or their containers).
- No gas cylinders.
- No agricultural equipment.
- No tyres, batteries, or car parts.

### METAL ITEMS



- Whitegoods with the doors removed.
- Hot water systems.
- Metal air conditioners.
- Dismantled metal play equipment.
- Lawnmowers



- Whitegoods left for collection could trap and suffocate young children. To avoid this danger, doors must be removed from whitegoods and other large air tight containers before disposal.
- Fuels and oils must be drained from lawnmowers.
- All appliance cords and hoses removed.

### GREENWASTE



- Vegetation and prunings must be tied in secure bundles with natural string.
- Bundles less than 60cm in diameter and 1 metre in length.



- No large branches, logs or tree stumps.
- No plastic string.
- No loose or unbundled materials.
- No landscaping materials.
