- iv. engage with local police, community safety organisations4 and residents as part of the audit and reporting process.

- iii. make an application to the Minister for Local Government through the Office of Local Government, pursuant to section 187(2) of the *Local Government Act 1993*, for the approval to acquire the land by compulsory process by the issue of proposed acquisition notices to the owners of the property;
- iv. make an application for the approval of the Governor, through the Office of Local Government, under section 19 of the *Land Acquisition (Just Terms Compensation)*Act 1991, to acquire the land by compulsory process by the publication of an acquisition notice in the NSW Government Gazette; and
- v. authorise the General Manager or their delegate to finalise and execute all relevant documents and compensation payable relating to the acquisition of the land.


