GUEST SPEAKERS

CAMDEN BANK STABILISATION PROJECT – Camden Council and NSW Soil Conservation: Presented By Rebecca Mabbott – NSW SCS

- Project to stabilise badly degraded section of Nepean Riverbank adjoining Fergusons Land cricket centre
- Bank was observed as damaged prior to 2022 floods and now even worse.
- Sydney Water is investigating methods for offsetting impacts from increased waste water loads from Sydney's growing population
- Nutrient offset projects can be used to offset Waste Water Treatment Plant licences to mitigate increased discharge
- Erosion control projects have been implemented previously by QLD water utilities for nutrient offsetting
- Sydney Water engaged SCS to investigate the feasibility of erosion control for nutrient offsetting and undertake a pilot project
- 200 m section of riverbank, 10 m high
- 30 m+ of riverbank retreat since 2016
- Continued scour erosion and mass failure/landslip
- 8 weeks on site, 2 weeks baseline survey, stockpiling & preparation, 4 weeks staged weed removal, earthmoving & LWD installation, 2 weeks – jute matting, fencing, planting, watering & demobilisation
- Access via Exeter St and Cricket centre.

KAREN THOROGOOD - CAMDEN COUNCIL NATURAL RESOURCES BIOSECURITY OFFICER

- Karen Thorogood introduced herself and her role to the Reference Group.
- Situated within the Sustainability Team
- Focussing on priority weeds across the LGA
- Aware that BEP is a hotspot for weeds due to animals visiting from across the country.
- Hopes to work with Precinct Team and Reference Group constructively.
- Will look into ongoing treatment of Gleditsia, Chilean Needle Gras and Blackberries all prevalent at BEP.
