

Camden BEP Chairpersons Report 12th June 2024

Hello All,

Winter has arrived and so have the east coast lows. We've all nervously watched a few rain

events come and go and thankfully we've been spared any serious flooding.

Unfortunately ESP's showjumping event was washed out over last weekend, however, we're

hopeful they'll be able to reschedule. With a few washouts needing to find future dates at

the Park it might be time to consider having spare dates set aside in the calendar as

contingency for such events. Please consider.

The Main arena is looking a bit used so I think all groups need to give thought to

remediation plans after events. While wear and tear is part every event we do need a plan for

how to repair any wear so that future events can also enjoy a suitable surface safely.

On this thought Council is looking to run a large community event next year with 10,000+

people on one of our arenas. As sports people we need to give careful consideration of the

impact of this on our competition surfaces now and in the future when they are improved.

The potential loss of event days and participants due to potential damage from such big non

equestrian uses could be detrimental to the Park.

Our steel horse yards are now all in and being used. The Council teams and a small group of

volunteers have done a great job getting them all installed so it's incumbent on all users to

respect the facilities, cleanup after yourself and tell those around you using the park to do

the same.

Good to see the waterlines down the Sheathers Lane end finally being done after first being

raised in 2019. Washbays are next.

We agreed on a permanent yard design last month. We should all be on the lookout for

grants to help fund the next phase of improving the equestrian infrastructure.
