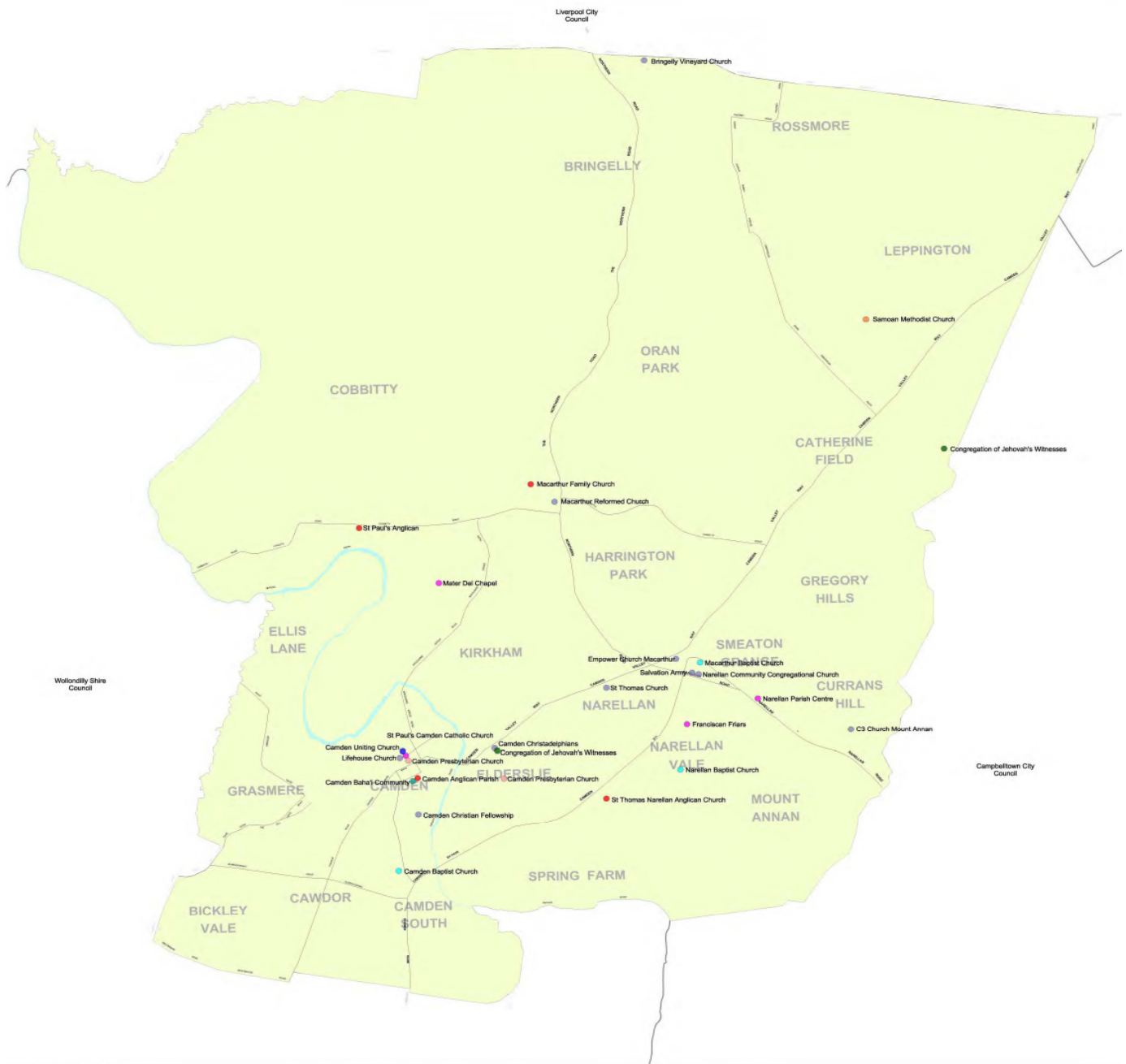

INTRODUCTION

This directory has been produced by Camden Council and aims to provide information to residents of and visitors to the Camden area, about the faith-based communities who live here, the places that residents go to worship and the services that organisations provide to the community.

FREEDOM OF RELIGION AND BELIEF

Freedom of religion and belief is a fundamental human right protected by a number of international treaties and declarations, including article 18(1) of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights (ICCPR).¹ This right encompasses freedom of thought on all matters and the freedom to manifest religion and belief individually or with others, in public or in private.

The right to freedom of religion is supported by the right to non-discrimination on the grounds of religion, contained in article 26 of the ICCPR. International human rights law also protects people against the promotion of religious hatred which amounts to incitement of discrimination, hostility or violence (ICCPR, article 20).

HUMAN RIGHTS

Human rights are about recognising and respecting the inherent value and dignity of all people. Human rights standards are contained in internationally agreed human rights treaties and declarations. The Australian Human Rights Commission is responsible for promoting and encouraging protection of human rights in Australia.²

THE PRINCIPLES OF MULTICULTURALISM³ IN NSW

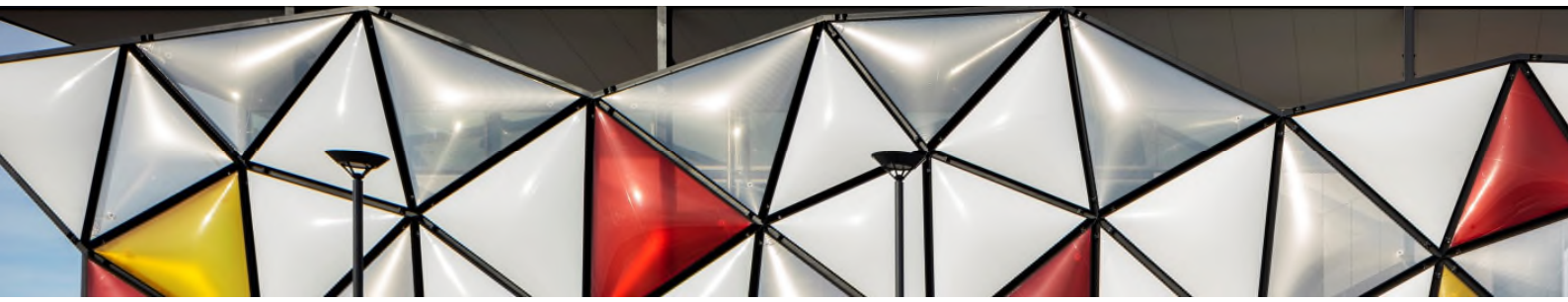
All New South Wales Government agencies are guided by the Principles of Multiculturalism, which are enshrined in State law. The principles confirm the right of individuals in New South Wales to:

- Fully contribute and participate in the life of the state;
- Respect the culture, language and religion of others (within a legal and constitutional framework where English is the common language);
- Have access to Government services; and
- Have the linguistic and cultural assets in New South Wales recognised and promoted.

RELIGIOUS AFFILIATIONS CAMDEN LGA

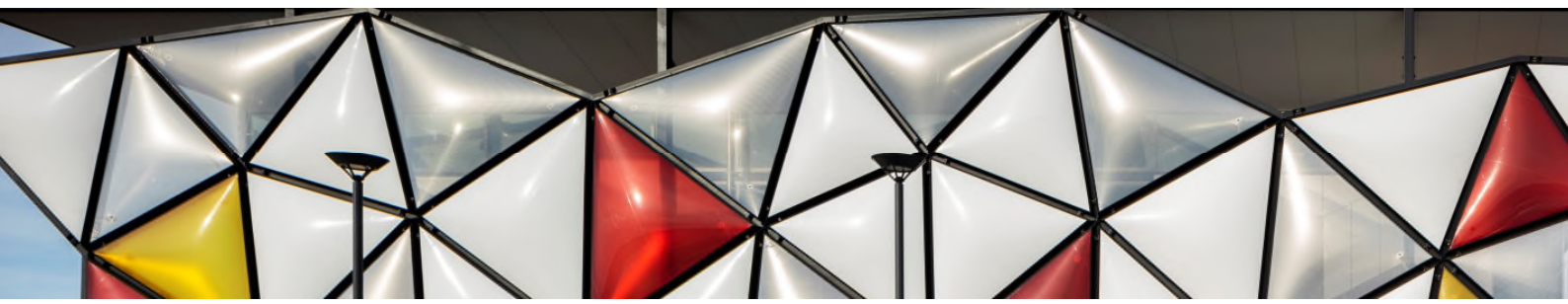
Camden Council area's religion statistics provide an indicator of cultural identity and ethnicity when observed in conjunction with other key variables. Religion data reveal the major concentrations of religions as well as revealing the proportion of people with no religious affiliation. There are a number of reasons for different religious compositions across areas including the country of birth and ethnic background of the population, the age of the population (belief in religion is generally stronger, the older the population) and changes in values and belief systems.

Camden Council area's religion statistics should be analysed in conjunction with other ethnicity statistics such as Country of Birth data and Language Spoken data to assist in identifying specific cultural and ethnic groups.

Please note, due to changes in ABS rules around perturbation and additivity of data to protect the confidentiality of individuals in 2016, counts of individual religion groups and totals derived from them may differ slightly from those published by the ABS. 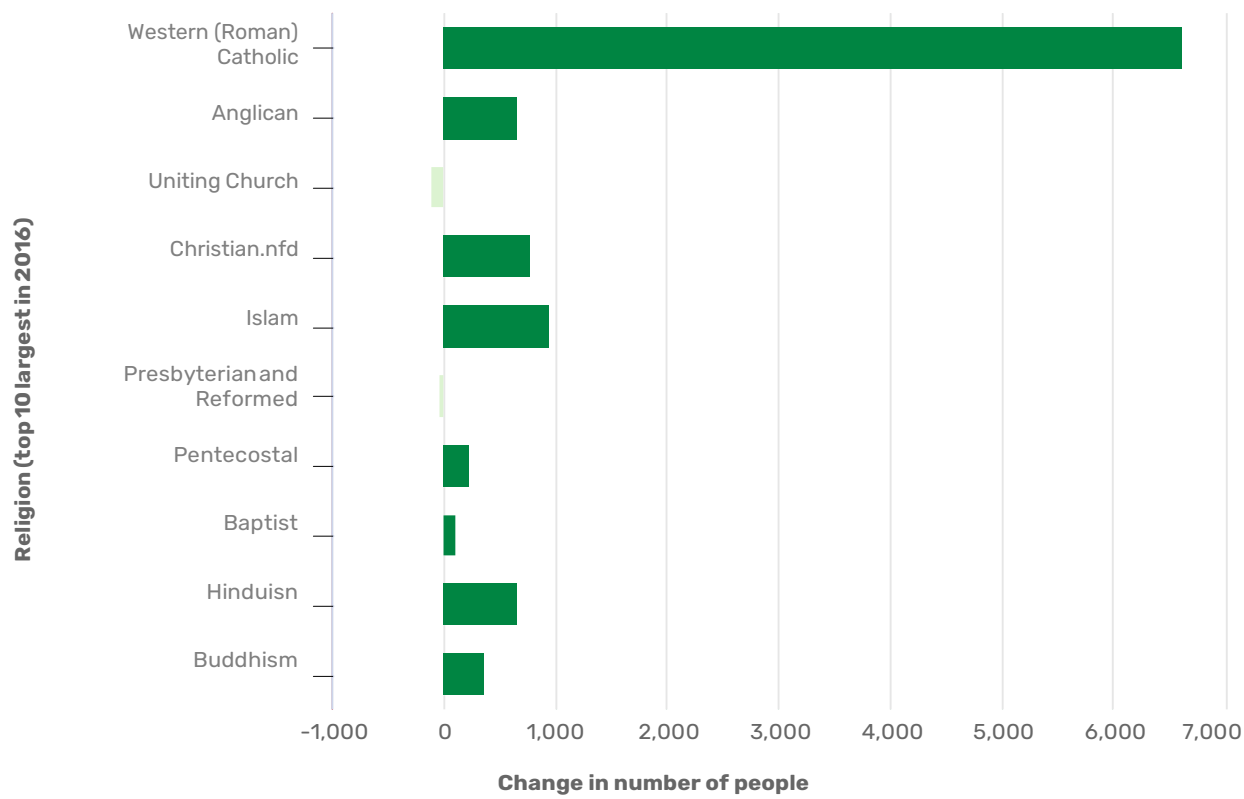

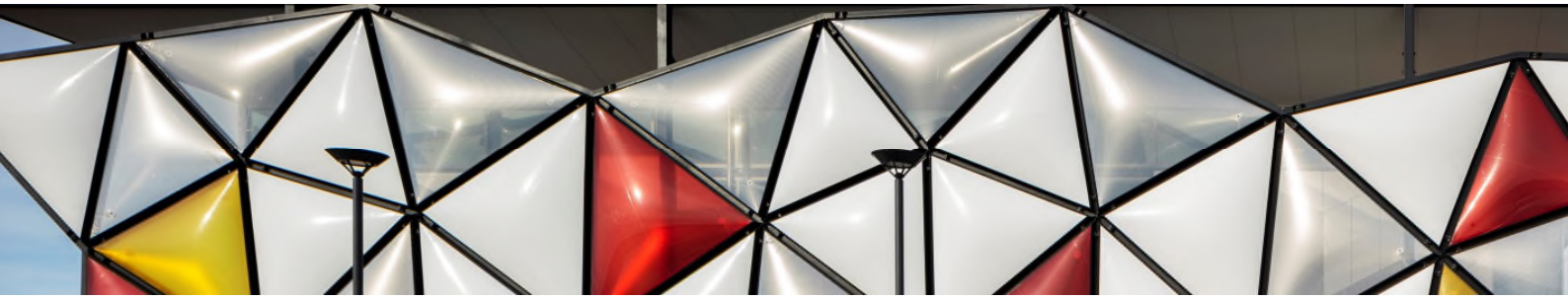


CHANGE IN RELIGION - 2011 TO 2016*

DOMINANT GROUPS

Analysis of the religious affiliation of the population of Camden Council area in 2016 compared to Greater Sydney shows that there was a higher proportion of people who professed a religion and a lower proportion who stated they had no religion.

Overall, 74.2% of the population nominated a religion, and 19.1% said they had no religion, compared with 66.2% and 24.9% respectively for Greater Sydney.

The largest single religion in Camden Council area was Western (Roman) Catholic, with 34.0% of the population or 26,589 people as adherents.

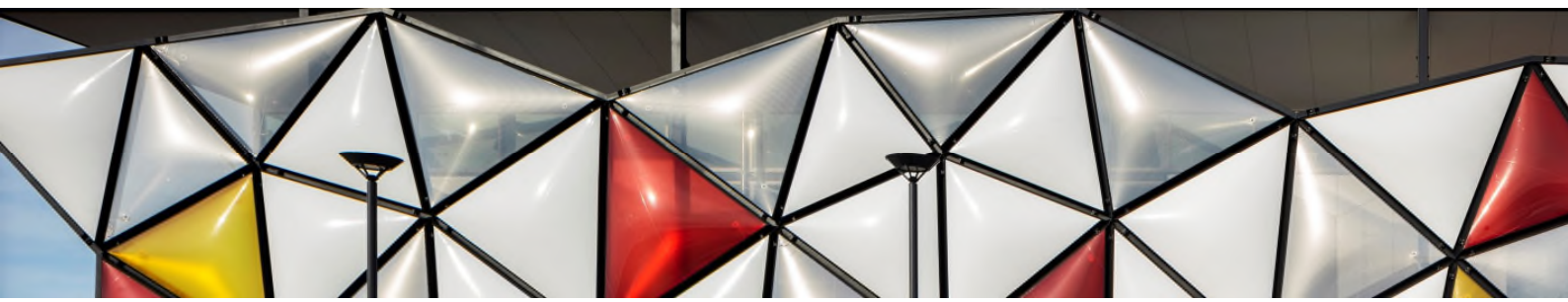
The major differences between the religious affiliation for the population of Camden Council area and Greater Sydney were:

- A *larger* percentage who nominated Western (Roman) Catholic (34.0% compared to 24.2%) A *larger* percentage who nominated Anglican (21.4% compared to 12.0%)
- A *smaller* percentage who nominated Islam (2.0% compared to 5.3%)
- A *smaller* percentage who nominated Buddhism (1.1% compared to 3.9%)

EMERGING GROUPS

The largest changes in the religious affiliation of the population in Camden Council area between 2011 and 2016 were for those who nominated:

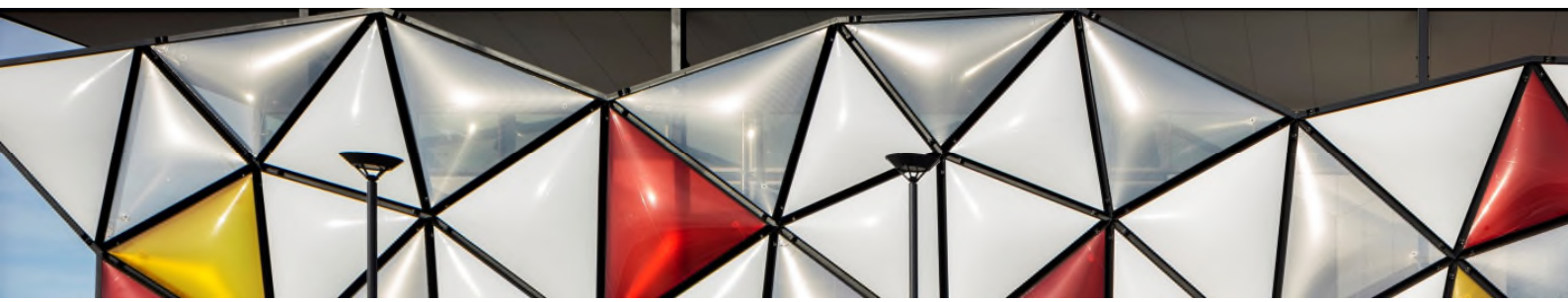
- Western (Roman) Catholic +6,627 persons)

Christadelphians believe that the Kingdom of God will soon be established on earth, with Jesus, God's only Son, as universal King. They focus on personal Bible study. There is no central authority dictating what is to be studied, or how it is to be interpreted. There is a common statement of Bible based faith, which binds the ecclesias (*Greek word for church*) together. They do not tithe, nor have a paid clergy.

The Christadelphians carefully substantiate their beliefs from the Bible while reproofing ideas whose roots are obviously of pagan origin and were voted into the Church to amalgamate pagan Rome, with Christianity. They do not believe that man has an immortal soul, but rather that Jesus will resurrect those who have truly known him, from the dead. The belief in a triune God, a fallen angel devil, and eternal fire torture is not scriptural - rather Christadelphians believe that man's nature is prone to sin, and that we must choose to follow Christ, just as He himself overcame sin.
