Free course to help raise teenagers

Parents of young people are invited to join in a free series of lessons to develop ways to support their teenage children.

Tuning in to Teens is a six-session parenting program to help discover ways to communicate with and better understand children who are 12-17 years old.

"It is at home where social skills, behaviours and emotional intelligence are established that form the foundation of our community," said Mayor Lara Symkowiak.
