SPRINGS LAKE - INVASIVE WEED SPRAYING

Pesticide spraying for aquatic and terrestrial weeds will be undertaken on Springs Lake and associated waterways.

Spraying is scheduled to commence from **22 November and will continue until 17 December 2021**, weather permitting. In the event of rain or unfavourable weather conditions, an extension of time will be required, and spraying will commence on the next suitable day. The public is advised not to use, drink the water or swim in these waterways during the above periods. The pesticide treatment is conducted in accordance with the *Pesticides Act 1999*.

All weed infestations will be foliar sprayed according to manufacturer's specifications with Metsulfuron-methyl 600g/kg at the rate of 10g per 100L of water. All chemicals are registered for this use in accordance with a permit issued by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority.

Under the provisions of the *Biosecurity Act 2015*, aquatic weeds such as Alligator weed are regional priority weeds. It is recommended to contact Councils Biosecurity Officer (Weeds) to obtain advice regarding the control of this weed if you have identified any on your property.
