Seniors Festival 2023 Review and Evaluation

Concerts

- Over 500 Seniors attended our entertainment program which included the Seniors Concert, Celebrating Seniors in Style Fashion Show and High Tea and the Forget-Me-Not Concert for people living with dementia and their carers.
- The Seniors Concert provided a diverse range of local performers and opportunity for participants to be part of the show, have a healthy meal, improve wellbeing, try new things, meet new people, have fun and enjoy social connections. (Attendance 195)
- Café Connect Forget-Me-Not Concert People living with Dementia (PLwD) and their Carers This concert designed specifically for (PLwD) showcased great entertainment, sing a longs and dancing which provided opportunities for enjoyment and connections in a safe and welcoming environment. (Attendance105)

• Celebrating Seniors in Style Fashion Show and High Tea

This event included local store's fashion which provided promotional opportunities, increased sales and connection to broader community, services and other businesses. Our volunteering Seniors models and MC built confidence and learnt new skills. There were also opportunities to engage and participate on diverse levels, roles and responsibilities.
