

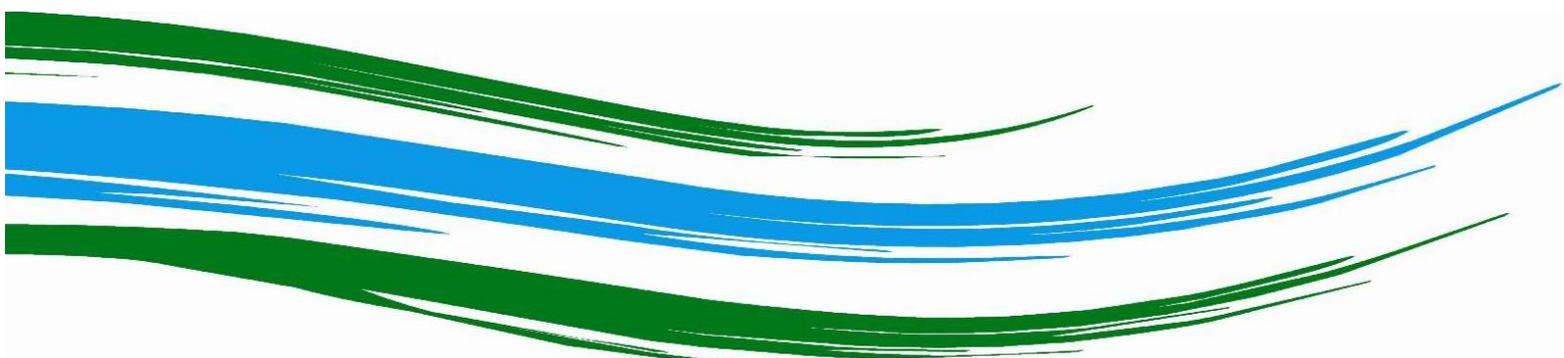

- ii. invite fresh tenders for the resurfacing of the main arena at Camden Bicentennial Equestrian Park based on a revised scope developed in consultation with the BEP Committee.
