BIRRIWA RESERVE OUTDOOR YOUTH SPACE

The need for an outdoor youth space with larger adventure playgrounds for 12-17 year olds was identified as a high priority in the 2014 Camden Recreation Demand Study.

Birriwa Reserve has been chosen as the location for a new outdoor youth space due to the high population of young people in the surrounding areas of Mount Annan, Narellan Vale and Currans Hill.

There are 4 main sections to the exciting new Birriwa Outdoor Youth Space

1. Main Play Space

The main play space includes a sunken youth area with shelter, seating, outdoor table tennis table, public art, dry river bed and small bridges.

The play space includes exciting and adventurous equipment designed for older children. A large climbing rope structure with a look out tower; 30m double cable ride, 3m slide, hip hop, sky surf, six way swing, basket swings, board rider, air rider and rodeo board as well as landscaping with rubber softfall, trees, shrubs and rocks.

2. Sunken Garden

A turfed area with seating, public art, barbeques, picnic setting with shade shelter, bubblers and toilet facilities which will be locked automatically after hours.



3. Multi-Purpose Courts and Car Park

Two fenced multi-purpose courts line marked for basketball, hockey and football and a 37 space car park to be locked after hours.

4. Pedestrian Tunnel and Walkway

New lighting and art work will be installed in the pedestrian walkway under Waterworth Drive to improve safety and amenity for pedestrians.

Overall the site will be landscaped with over 80 new trees to be planted and new fencing installed along Welling and Waterworth Drives. Lighting will be provided for the multi-purpose courts, car park and toilet facility.

Timeframe

This project is expected to commence in the 2015/2016 financial year.

Value of works is \$1.4 million.
