Grand opening this weekend for Harrington Park play space

Harrington Park Lake Reserve Youth Play Space will officially open this weekend with a family fun event to celebrate.

The \$1.14 million recreational development includes play equipment, specialised areas for skateboarding, bike riding or roller blading, as well as a Ninja Warrior style apparatus.

The event will be the first chance for children and young people to try the new facilities and enjoy a range of activities on offer.

Mayor Peter Sidgreaves said the opening celebration marked an important milestone for Council.

“This new youth play space is the first of our major parks projects to open in 2018 and will be followed by Sedgewick Reserve Youth Space and Curry Reserve Water Play Park in the coming weeks,” Cr Sidgreaves said.

“We are extremely proud of this facility and look forward to seeing families and children visit the space for the first time,” he said.

“It’s going to be a great day out and I encourage all residents to come along and enjoy some outdoor time with their families.”

“By providing new and interactive recreational spaces, Council aims to set a strong foundation to will accommodate for growth and our future communities,” he said.

The opening event will be held 10am - 2pm, Saturday 3 November and include face painting, garden games, jumping castles, parasol painting and live music.

Staff from RecAlley will be on hand to teach kids how to use the new outdoor equipment and a sausage sizzle and other food stalls will be available.
