Mount Annan Leisure Centre pool upgrade works

Council is continuing the transformation of Mount Annan Leisure Centre with renewal works

planned for the aquatic facilities requiring the pool's closure for six weeks. The current pool is 15

years old and is in need of upgrade works.

Improvements to the existing pool facilities will bring the project to a total of \$14 million and include

upgrades to change rooms, installation of new pool pumps and other repair and maintenance

works.

"Delivering new sport and recreational facilities is a major part of Council's community focus. This

is an exciting project that will support the health and wellbeing of our residents now and into the

future," said Mayor Lara Symkowiak.

"Council and the YMCA, who operate the facility, will continue to provide regular updates and keep

the community engaged in this upgrade process," Cr Symkowiak said.

Work continues on the leisure centre upgrade and expansion with the construction of new

amenities, multipurpose sports hall, the expansion of the child care facilities, additional car parking

and upgrades to the entry foyer, kiosk and change rooms are all well on track.

The swimming pool and facilities within the pool area will be closed from 26 April, with works

scheduled to be completed and the pool reopened on 5 June 2017.

Members will be contacted by centre management about discounted rates to compensate for

possible inconvenience created during the works.
