The Bushcare Trailer was officially unveiled by the Mayor of Camden, Councillor Lara Symkowiak and State Member for Camden, Chris Patterson MP on Tuesday 8 April 2014 at Chellaston Reserve, Camden following a grant from the Minister for Environment, Robin Parker.

The grant for \$2,250 was awarded under the Minister's Conservation Fund and was matched dollar-for-dollar by Camden Council. The funding was used to fit out a trailer for the use of the Kings Bush Bushcare Group and Camden Community Gardens for use in their environmental projects.
