Camden's Youth Program Best in the State!

Camden Council was awarded the **Best** Local Youth Week Program 2014 Award at the Local Government Awards for Youth Week at Parliament House, Sydney on Thursday 7 August 2014.

Camden's 2014 Youth Week Program saw 1,692 local young people attend and participate in 31 activities – the highest participation rate Camden has ever seen. The activities were organised by Camden Youth Council, a sub-Council of Camden Council, in partnership with 12 different organisations including schools, youth services, local businesses and community groups.

Mayor of Camden, Councillor Lara Symkowiak said she was extremely proud of the Award.
