FUNDING INJECTION FOR LOCAL ROADS PROJECTS

Council has received the green light for \$8.4 million in additional funding towards local roads projects in the second round of the Australian Government funded Local Roads Package for Western Sydney.

Mayor of Camden, Cr Lara Symkowiak said the funding, which is part of the \$3.6 billion Western Sydney Infrastructure Plan, is a fantastic win for current and future residents in the Camden LGA.

“This significant investment in our roads will help to improve local transport connections, ease congestion and cut down travel times for residents, which means this valuable time can be spent with family.”

“This quality infrastructure will not only improve the safety and efficiency of local roads, it will also help to open up further opportunities for economic growth and job creation.”

“This is a very welcome announcement and I thank Mr Russell Matheson, Member for Macarthur for his assistance with securing this funding and Mr Chris Patterson for advocating on Camden Council’s behalf.” Cr Symkowiak said.

Funding has been approved for the following projects:

- **Camden Valley Way/Argyle St**, Macarthur Road Intersection
\$5.6 million for construction of traffic signals (\$1.3 million of this is funded by Council)
- **Camden Valley Way/Argyle St**, Grahams Hill and Richardson Roads Intersection
\$4 million for detailed designs and traffic light improvements
- **Porrende Street Upgrade**, Narellan
\$120,000 for detailed designs for upgrading the existing roundabout at the entry to the site of the new Narellan Sports Hub.
