- Winter menus at venues along Argyle Street including the Epicure Store, Burger Frank, Upstairs @

- Buskers and street performers providing entertainment throughout Camden Town Centre.

Mayor of Camden, Cr Theresa Fedeli said Winterfest Camden was shaping up to be one of the most exciting events on the calendar.

"It's truly magical to have such an exciting winter wonderland set up in Camden including having an ice rink in the middle of Larkin Place for the community to enjoy," Cr Fedeli said.

"This is the first time Camden has had its very own ice rink plus a range of food, kid's activities and winter warming drinks on offer, and it will be a great way to celebrate the improvements made to Argyle Street and the Camden Town Centre recently.
