Residents now have the opportunity to read with their children while waiting at a number of participating organisations across Camden, thanks to new Book Boxes.

The initiative, coordinated by Camden Paint the Town REaD and supported by Council, involves eight wooden boxes, built by Camden Men's Shed, that are filled with a variety of donated books for young readers.

Mayor of Camden, Cr Peter Sidgreaves, said it was the perfect opportunity for parents and carers to switch off their devices and, instead, pass the waiting time with something stimulating.

"As the father of four young girls, I know how important it is to read with our young ones. It not only helps them with language and listening skills, it also improves communication, concentration and works as a stress reliever," Cr Sidgreaves said.

"Camden Paint the Town REaD is an initiative which encourages everyone to read, talk, sing and rhyme with children from birth, and these Book Boxes do just that."
