Camden Civic Centre shows selling out fast

Two exciting, high-profile shows are coming to Camden Civic Centre later this year – and tickets are already flying out the (theatre) door!

They include:

- Play School Live in Concert, Humpty's Showtime, on Friday 11 October, 10am and noon. The 45-minute show, featuring Humpty Dumpty along with lots of Play School favourites, will be filled with fun songs to sing and dance along with. Tickets are \$22 each, plus a booking fee; and
- Arj Barker's We Need to Talk on Friday 22 November, 7.30pm. This 90-minute comedy show is back by popular demand and has earned lots of rave reviews. This show is recommended for residents aged 15 years and over, with tickets at \$49.90 each, plus a booking fee.

Camden Mayor of Camden, Cr Theresa Fedeli, urged residents to secure their seats now.

"Don't fall into the trap of thinking you have plenty of time to buy a ticket – these shows might be a few months away, but they are both incredibly popular and are expected to sell out!" Cr Fedeli said.

"Shows like these are often held in theatres that are quite inaccessible for our residents. As a mother, and a grandmother, I know it's not easy to haul your children into Sydney City or Parramatta to see the likes of Play School. And, as someone who works full time, I know these places aren't easy to get to for a comedy show on a Friday night after work either.
