Legal Talk series at Camden's Libraries

Camden Council's Libraries are hosting a Legal Talk series, with a number of workshops designed to discuss legal issues relating to residents of all ages and life stages.

The Legal Talk series includes:

- Wills, Power of Attorney and Enduring Guardian on 29 May, 6pm, at Narellan Library. This workshop will teach attendees the importance of planning ahead and what to consider;
- HSC Legal Studies Seminar on 3 July, 6pm, at Narellan Library. For students in Year 12 studying the Legal Studies course, this will be a question and answer session with a Senior Solicitor from Macarthur Legal Centre;
- Family Law Parenting After Separation on 3 September, 6pm, at Oran Park Library. This workshop will look at parenting after separation, property settlement, divorce and child support; and
- Legal Issues for Seniors on 19 November, 6pm, at Oran Park Library. This session will
 cover what to consider when building a granny flat, fee arrangements for assisted living
 facilities and things to consider when downsizing.

Mayor of Camden, Cr Theresa Fedeli, said it was important residents know what's legally expected of them and what their rights are.

"The law is often difficult to understand, so I'm proud Council can provide assistance in this way," Cr Fedeli said.

"Having these sessions makes it easier for people to learn about topics relevant to them. Being able to engage with the person running the workshop is fantastic for residents who need questions answered on the spot."
