## Effie is asking Camden to "Love Me Tinder"

Residents are invited to see the Logie-winning queen of comedy, Effie, up close and very 'personals' at Camden Civic Centre.

The show, Love Me Tinder, will be on Saturday 30 November, with doors opening at 8pm for an 8.30pm start. The Acropolis Now actress will explore the complexities of finding love as only she can — who isn't on Tinder? How can we humans claim to be evolved and yet still have such animal urges? Is the urge to swipe left or right, or to scratch that seven-year itch, too hard to resist, even with the greatest of willpowers?

Tickets for *Love Me Tinder* are \$45, plus a booking fee, and are recommended for residents aged 15 years and over.

Mayor of Camden, Cr Theresa Fedeli, urged residents to secure tickets now.

"Effie is returning to Camden Civic Theatre due to popular demand," Cr Fedeli said.

"Her first show earlier this year was a sell out and attendees absolutely raved about her performance. We're expecting tickets to go quickly in these last few weeks leading up to her show so don't fall into the trap of thinking you have plenty of time to buy a ticket.

"Shows like these are often held in theatres that are inaccessible for our residents. As a family woman and someone who works full time, I know it's not easy to organise baby-sitters and travel long distances to enjoy a comedy show on a Saturday night.

"Which is why I am so proud we're able to continually offer some of the best entertainment right here in Camden."

Camden Civic Centre has a number of other popular shows coming up, including:

- Arj Barker's We Need to Talk on Friday 22 November, 7.30pm. Tickets for this show are \$49.90, plus
  a booking fee, and are recommended for residents aged 15 years and over;
- The World is a Stage on Sunday 24 November, 3-5pm. The South West Sydney Philharmonic and Fisher's Ghost Youth Orchestra will play favourites from opera, ballet, theatre and classic cinema in a show suitable for all ages. Prices will be \$20 for each concession ticket, \$25 for an adult ticket and \$60 for a family pass; and
- An Evening with Spirit on Thursday 28 November, 7.30-9pm. Experienced mediums Maria and Val will help attendees connect to their loved ones in spirit. Prices will be \$20 for each ticket purchased online, \$40 for at-the-door general tickets and \$20 for at-the-door concession and senior tickets.
