## One small step for kids, one giant leap for school holiday fun

See the moon and stars like you've never seen them before, from inside the ground-breaking, 360 degree, fully interactive Planetarium Dome!

Camden Council is hosting the Starr's Planetarium exhibition, Moon Madness!, on **Tuesday 8 October, 10am-4.30pm, at Oran Park Library**, as part of its exciting school holiday program.

Founder of Starr's Planetarium, Gary Starr, said children will feel like they're really in space.

"You'll be able to take a trip through the solar system and onwards to the very edge of our galaxy, thanks to the movies shown in the dome," Mr Starr said.

"Being immersed in a stunning 360-degree movie really is amazing. The 3D digital images and surround sound creates a spectacular space adventure.

"Then come back down to Earth to find out what's in the sky tonight. Our presenter-led astronomy shows are really informative and engaging. It is a must-experience for every child!"

Participants can choose from three different immersive, 3D digital movies with surround sound, including:

- Earth's Wild Ride at 10am and 11am;
- Moonbase at noon and 1.30pm; and
- Astronaut at 2.30pm, 3.30pm and 4.30pm.

Tickets for Moon Madness! are \$4 and must be purchased to enter the dome. Children under seven years must be accompanied by an adult.

To keep kids curious and entertained over the school holidays, Camden Libraries will also run:

Pyjama Party Storytime and Stuffed Animal Sleepover on Tuesday 1 October, 6-7pm, at Oran Park Library and Thursday 3 October, 5.30-6.30pm, at Narellan Library.
 Children are invited to wear their pyjamas and bring their favourite stuffed animal to listen to stories before bed. Children will also have the option of leaving their stuffed animal at the library for a sleepover with their friends – and staff will send photos of what they got up to in the library overnight. A light bedtime snack will be served at this FREE event;
