Mayor of Camden, Cr Theresa Fedeli, said the 22 locations with the most votes will feature on the game.

"With so many deserving landmarks, and so many choices in the poll, it's so important our residents jump online and vote for the locations that are special to them," Cr Fedeli said.

"Camden is one of the most beautiful locations in the country, with so much history and natural beauty. I'm so excited to see what spaces make the cut.

"The locations and landmarks chosen will play a special role in selling the game. This is really important because all the funds received from the sale of the game will be donated to Lifeline Macarthur and the Camden Wollondilly Domestic Violence Committee. We want to raise as much money as we can for these two very deserving organisations."

The game is due to hit the shelves in time for Christmas and will be available for purchase, for \$60, at:
