#### **HAC05 ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION**

  - The Committee discussed a possible project that would require grant funding from the Government to research and collate the Aboriginal history of the Community.
2. Glenda Chalker to provide an overview to the Committee of the new heritage Aboriginal reforms.
  - Glenda provided an update to the Committee on the new Aboriginal Heritage Reforms and advised the Minister for Aboriginal Affairs and Minister for Environment and Heritage have decided more targeted consultation is needed.
3. Options on providing the heritage lists contained within the LEP somewhere more accessible to the public.
  - It was noted that the Local and State Heritage Items listed in the LEP and Growth Centres State Environmental Planning Policy (2006) have been uploaded to the Heritage Conservation page on Council's website.
4. Options for a Residential Style Guide.
  - This item was noted.
