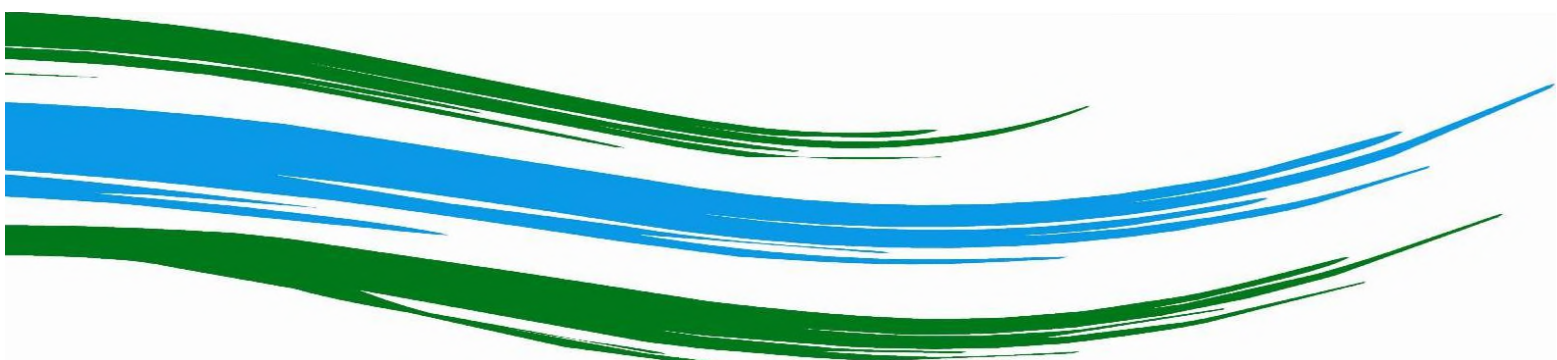




Camden Council Minutes

HAC01 Leaves Of Absence

Resolution: Moved Councillor Campbell, Seconded Ms Aulsebrook, that Mr Kennedy, Mr McIntosh and Ms Chalker be granted a leave of absence.

HAC02 Confirmation Of Minutes

Resolution: Moved Ms Aulsebrook, Seconded Councillor C Cagney, that the Heritage Advisory Committee confirm and adopt the meeting minutes of 13 August 2020.

HAC03 Heritage Mapping Project

Resolution: Moved Dr Willis, Seconded Ms Aulsebrook, that the Heritage Advisory Committee:

- i. note the information in this report and presentation; and
- ii. provide input into the methodology associated with future community engagement.
- iii. acknowledge the input and work for this project by Ian McIntosh and the Council officers is very much appreciated.

ACTIONS

- Consider the possibility of the committee leading a project over December/January as a holiday activity including: social media promotions, our Camden stories and invite members of the public to share their historical stories.
- Strategic Planning officers to propose next steps to the committee by having a draft Communications Strategy prepared and distributed to the committee members via email with a view to finalising it at the committee's December meeting.
- Consider a Heritage Advisory sub-committee meeting in November 2020 to consider the draft Communications Strategy for the project.

HAC04 Proposed Place Naming – “Holmes Park” Leppington

Resolution: Moved Dr Willis, Seconded Councillor C Cagney, that the Heritage Advisory Committee note the proposed place naming “Holmes Park” in Leppington.

HAC05 Heritage Affected Development Application Listing - August - September 2020

Resolution: Moved Dr Willis, Seconded Ms Aulsebrook, that the Heritage Advisory Committee:

- i. note the information provided to the Committee.
- ii. note that the DA for 5 Smalls Road, Grasmere would be best suited for the area if the height restriction in the LEP was maintained.

HAC06 General Business

Resolution: Moved Councillor Campbell, Seconded Ms Aulsebrook, that the Heritage Advisory Committee decide on any actions arising from general business.

- Noted that an expression of interest has been received from Venessa Possum to nominate for membership of the committee (representing Camden's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community).
- Under the Committee's Terms of Reference, written nomination of Venessa Possum is required from an organisation representing Camden's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community. Council officers intend to undertake consultation with these groups.
- Unlock Camden online event was discussed, including the amount of community interest in the event.
- The potential for the Camden Visitor Centre to host a screen for visitors to view the Unlock Camden event footage was noted.

ACTION

- Team Leader Land Use Planning to consult with local Aboriginal groups and prepare a report to Council for consideration.
- Team Leader Land Use Planning to advise on who is currently speaking for the Gundungurra Aboriginal Group.
- Manager Strategic Planning to provide the committee with the statistics on the number of views of the unlock Camden Event.

HAC07 Action Register

Resolution: Moved Councillor Campbell, Seconded Ms Aulsebrook, that the Heritage Advisory Committee note the status of the action register for August 2020.
