## HOW TO ORGANISE YOUR KERBSIDE COLLECTION SERVICE

Book your collection online or contact Council on 4654 7777. Do not put your unwanted material on the kerbside until you have made a booking with Council.

Place your material on the kerb no earlier than 2 days before your scheduled collection day.

Material must be clear of obstructions such as vehicles.

Get the volume right, we collect 3 cubic metres of material (3mx1mx1m) per collection

Our service will pickup most furniture and house hold items. Separate your material into 2 piles for metals and general material. Place small loose items in boxes or bag for easy collection.

# STILL TOO MUCH MATERIAL? ADDITIONAL SERVICES AVAILABLE

Residents receive (3) kerbside collections per financial year. If you have used your (3) collections another kerbside collection service can be booked at an additional fee.

This fee is payable to Council's Customer Service Team in person or over the phone. Online bookings are not available for additional bookings.

Other options for disposing your waste include taking your waste to Macarthur Resource Recovery Park in Spring Farm. Items that can be reused may be accepted by local charities.

#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- The details on this brochure (or updated versions thereof) form part of the terms and conditions of the Kerbside Collections Service.
- The kerbside is public land. Any materials placed on the kerbside in a manner contrary to these terms and conditions may be considered littering or waste pollution of land which are prosecutable offences under the POEO Act, 1997.
- Only (3) collections per financial year are available to each residential property.
- Bookings are based on availability. Council makes no guarantee as to the time elapse from call to booking date.
- Kerbside Collection Services to multi-unit dwellings may be available only by special arrangement.
- Council reserves the right to allocate the date of the collection day at the point of booking and to change it where necessary.
- This service is not available to commercial or industrial properties.
- All material placed on the kerbside is considered the property owner or tenant's responsibility until collected by Council.

A TOTAL OF THREE (3) CUBIC METRES OF MATERIAL WILL BE ACCEPTED

## **GENERAL ITEMS**

#### **ITEMS WE CAN COLLECT:**

- Bulky household items such as furniture
- Mattresses (max. 4)
- Children's toys
- Barbeques (not the gas bottle)
- Carpet cut and rolled into 1 metre lengths (max. 1 room)
- Small and loose material in bags or boxes



#### **ITEMS WE CANNOT COLLECT:**

- Food waste or recyclables
- Construction, asbestos, demolition or renovation materials (eg. kitchen or bathroom material)
- Hazardous waste (eg. fuel, paint, paint containers, oil, acid, thinners)
- Gas cyclinders
- · Agricultural equipment
- Tyres, batteries or car parts
- Anything longer than 2 metres









## **METAL ITEMS**

#### **ITEMS WE CAN COLLECT:**

- Whitegoods with the doors removed
- Hot water systems
- Metal air conditioners
- · Dismantled metal play equipment
- Lawn mowers









#### **ITEMS WE CANNOT COLLECT:**

- Items with doors attached left for collection could trap and suffocate young children. To avoid this danger, doors must be removed from whitegoods and other large air tight containers before disposal
- Fuels and oils must be drained from lawn mowers.



## **GREENWASTE ITEMS**

#### **ITEMS WE CAN COLLECT:**

- Vegetation and prunings must be tied in secure bundles
- Bundles less than 60cm in diametre and 1 metre in length



#### **ITEMS WE CANNOT COLLECT:**

- No large branches, logs or tree stumps
- No loose or unbundled materials
- No fencing or landscaping materials
