

Entry Conditions

- Dogs must be on leash and under effective control of a competent person over the age of 16 years within the Bicentennial Equestrian Park.
- The total number of dogs a person has effective control of must not exceed four.
- By attending you confirm that your dog is fully up to date with all vaccinations, flea and worm treatments, and is in no way a danger to other dogs or members of the public.
- By attending you agree that your dog is appropriately trained and socialised to handle a crowded public environment.
- All attendees are responsible for the health and safety of themselves and their dog. Camden Council will not accept any liability for personal or property damages (including your dog), losses (including surrendered items), or injuries sustained to you or your dog at this event, including the 2km walking track.
- Dogs deemed as troublesome, dangerous or menacing may be asked to leave the facility at any time. This decision will be at the full discretion of the event organiser.
- All dog owners must clean/pick up any mess caused by their dog(s) with poo bags and dispose of them properly. Owners should bring your own poo bags, however they are also available from the Camden Council marquee.
- There are multiple taps and dog bowls located around the venue. Owners may bring your own water bowl or utilise the bowls provided. By using the communal bowls at the event, you understand and agree that this is at your own risk and Camden Council will not be liable for any issues arising out of the use of the communal bowls.
- You agree that should any incident occur between you, your dog, other dogs or any person present at the event that Camden Council will in no way be held responsible or liable for any damage, accident or unforeseen circumstances that may occur as a result of the incident.
- Children are to be supervised by an adult at all times to prevent actions that may excite, scare, tease or intimidate dogs.
- This event is being filmed and photographed. By entering this event you agree to being filmed or photographed and accept that the footage/photographs may be used for marketing or promotional purposes.
- All entrants understand and agree that other media outlets external to Camden Council may film, cover, air, stream, post, print or otherwise publish (including on online social media) any part of the event. Camden Council cannot be held responsible for coverage by any other media outlet, including any adverse effects on the entrant.
- The event organiser reserves the right, at its full discretion, to refuse entry to, or evict, any person who does not comply with the Entry Conditions.
